Entries:

Checks payable to Suddenly Farm must accompany entry.

Entries will not be accepted without full payment.

No email, telephone, or fax entries

Refunds prior to closing date minus a \$10 processing fee.

No refunds after closing date.

Negative coggins dated within 12 months of show required with entry.

Management reserves the right to cancel/combine classes at its discretion.

If necessary, a waiting list will be established.

A second judge may be added if entries warrant.

Please note - our shows tend to fill quickly so please enter early!!

Show may close prior to closing date if show fills early.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded through 10th place with a prize for 1st.

Champion and Reserve in all divisions with 3 or more riders in two or more classes.

"Special Award" - At each show we will give away a \$25 gift certificate for use at a future Suddenly Farm show. The criteria for the award will be different for each show - visit secretary stand on show day for more info.

Ride times will be available on website as soon as schedule is finalized.

Other Information:

Competition arena: One standard arena with sand footing.

Warm-up is available outside on grass or in indoor with sand footing.

There is a small area outside with sand footing for the few riders "on deck".

Large parking area.

Helmets must be worn while mounted.

All dogs **MUST** be leashed and kept away from dressage arena.

The gate into the parking area is a DRIVE THRU gate. No traffic on main driveway on show days.
